

GENERAL RULES

The Boone County Beef Showdown is a junior show
4-H age rule applies: Age 8-18 as of September 1, 2017 – please be prepared to show photo ID or other proof of age.
All out of state cattle MUST present health papers

Generators are strongly encouraged

The Boone County 4-H Beef Committee and Boone County Fairgrounds are not liable for any accidents or losses

All individuals that stall at their trailers are responsible to clean up any bedding in your area (manure spreader available).

Five head are required to maintain a breed division. If there are not five head present for a certain breed, the animal(s) will be shown in the AOB division

➡ Original registration papers are required to show in a breed class (Applies to BOTH steers AND heifers)

Market steers will be shown by breed and weight

- F Breeding heifers will be shown by breed and age
- Market heifers will be shown by weight in a steer division
- FC Classes are split at the *discretion of the committee*

■ Breed heifers must be born **between** September 1st, 2016 and December 31st, 2017

- Market animals must be born after December 31st, 2016
- All grievances must be made before classes are placed
