### General Show Rules

\*This show is open for any child 18 years of age and under (MSA (sheep) rules allow collegiate showmen)

\*All exhibitors must be in good standings with a FFA chapter, 4H Club or a member of a cattle, sheep association.

\*ALL exhibitors will sign a registration form 18 & under must have parent's signature

\*All animals must have a current Health Certificate from an accredited Vet

### Cattle Show Rules

#### Market Steers

- Cattle Check in on Sunday; February 14, 2016 is from 7am to 9am..... show starts at 10:30 am
- Steers will be weighed in from 8-9:30am
- Classes will be determined by final weights
- There is only 2 divisions for steers.... Brahman influenced and AOB

#### Heifers

- Heifers will be checked in on Sunday; February 14, 2016 from 7-9am... show starts at 10am
- Heifers will be weighed in from 8-9:30am
- Classes will be determined by age
- There will be 2 divisions for Heifers Brahman influenced and AOB
- There must minimum of 10 heifers in each division to make separate shows, otherwise there will be a combined show.
- All heifers must be 36 months or younger

**\*\*\*THIS IS A NO BULL SHOW\*\*\***

Top 5 steers and top 5 heifers will be recognized

## Sheep Show Rules

### MSA SHOW RULES ALSO APPLY

CHECK IN on Saturday; wFebruary 13, 2016 from 7:00 - 9:30 AM - Show starts at 10:30 am

- **Market Lambs**- Market Lambs will be shown by weight. Lambs will be weighed in at the time of check-in between 7:00 and 7:30 AM shown in the market lamb show.
- The market lamb show will not be broken into separate divisions.
- **Ewes** – Breeding ewes will be shown by age and broken into the following divisions: black face ewes, white face ewes, all other wool ewes, and all other haired ewes.
- There must be a minimum of 10 ewes in each division to make a separate show, otherwise there will be a combined show.
- All breeding ewes must be 48 months of age or under.  
Division verification is required at time of check-in for all divisions.
- **Rams** – Breeding rams will be shown by age and broken into the following divisions: black face rams, white face rams, all other wool rams, all other haired rams.
- There must be a minimum of 10 rams in each division to make a separate show; otherwise there will be a combined show.
- All breeding rams must be 48 months of age or under.
- Division verification is required at time of check-in for all divisions.

**TOP 5 MARKET LAMB, BREEDING EWE, AND BREEDING RAM WILL BE RECOGNIZED.**

### Showmanship Contest

There will be a showmanship contest held on each day for cattle, goats, and sheep. The showmanship contest is an additional \$10.00 fee. The divisions are: Pee-Wee (7 and under and must be accompanied by a handler), Junior (8 to 11), Intermediate (12 to 14), Senior (15 to 18) Age as of September 1, 2015

### Shade, Generators and Wash Racks

- There will be no shade or tie-outs available - Please bring your own shade
- There will be NO barn ties, you must tie to your trailer.
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to provide his/her own power for cooling and grooming their animals.
- There is a limited supply of water and wash rack facilities
  
- It is the sole responsibility of the showman to remove bedding and trash from their area after the completion of their show. This includes straw, shavings, grooming products, wool/hair, and trash.

Ethical Treatment of Animals

- All animals are expected to be treated in an ethical and humane way. Failure to do so may cause the exhibitor and animal(s) to be disqualified.
